



NOTICE TO ALL LICENSED PSYCHOLOGISTS AND PSYCHOLOGY ASSISTANTS

Effective March 4, 2011, as a condition of license or registration renewal, Board licensees and registrants who have not previously submitted fingerprints to the Department of Justice (DOJ) or for whom an electronic fingerprint record does not exist must submit a set of fingerprints to the DOJ, as directed by the board, for the purpose of conducting a criminal history record check. The Board will also require licensees and registrants to disclose any disciplinary action against their licensure by any government agency or disciplinary body since they last renewed their license.

The Board has identified licensees and registrants who require electronic record of their prints. The Board will provide further information/instructions to these licensees and registrants by mail as soon as the Board's system implementation is complete.

In addition, as a condition of renewal, licensees and registrants are required to disclose whether, since they last renewed their license or registration, they have been convicted of any violation of the law in this or any other state, the United States or its territories, military court, or other country, omitting traffic infractions under \$500.00 not involving alcohol, a dangerous drug, or a controlled substance.
